



BES (Barriere Emergency Services) Golf Tournament Bursary

The criteria for the \$500.00 bursary is as follows:

1. Priority will be given to an applicant going into one of the following emergency services fields; first responder/paramedic, fire rescue, medical or law enforcement. If this criteria is not met the bursary may then be awarded, at the discretion of the tournament coordinators, to a qualified applicant.
2. The applicant must be enrolled in a post-secondary program including, but not limited to; University, College, Trade School, JIBC, Firefighting Training, EHS Training, RCMP Depot.
3. Applicants must provide proof of enrollment with acceptance.
4. Applicants must provide a certified copy of their high school transcript
5. Applicants must provide a letter of support from a community member/leader or teacher that displays the applicant's community involvement or volunteering. This letter of support is to be no more than one page in length.
6. The applicant will provide a cover letter (one page maximum) that will accompany the application package. This letter will outline the applicant's reason for applying, expected career direction and short term goals.
7. The applicant must have all required documents attached to the application package for the submission to be considered by the Bursary committee.
 - a. Cover Letter
 - b. Letter of Support
 - c. Transcript
 - d. Proof of enrollment or application to post-secondary program
8. The applicant will receive the funds awarded to them after they have completed the first day of the program they were enrolled in.
9. The deadline to receive applications will follow the deadline set by the Barriere Secondary School.
10. All applications will be received by the school and forward to the BES Golf Tournament Bursary Committee for review and final decision.
